Accolades

- ◆ In its annual publication “America’s Best Colleges,” *U.S. News & World Report* ranks UCI among the top 41 universities in the nation.
- ◆ UCI is the youngest of only 63 universities in the U.S. and Canada elected to membership in the prestigious Association of American Universities.
- ◆ Three UCI researchers have won Nobel Prizes: F. Sherwood Rowland and Irwin Rose in chemistry, and Frederick Reines in physics.
- ◆ Orange County’s only university healthcare facility, UC Irvine Medical Center offers acute- and general-care services at its new, 482,000-square-foot UC Irvine Douglas Hospital and is home to the county’s only Level I trauma center, American College of Surgeons-verified regional burn center and National Cancer Institute-designated comprehensive cancer center. *U.S. News & World Report* has included UC Irvine for 10 consecutive years on its list of America’s Best Hospitals, giving special recognition to three specialty programs.
- ◆ The Paul Merage School of Business M.B.A. programs consistently rank among the best in the world, including No. 1 in the U.S. for employment of M.B.A. students within three months of graduation by *Financial Times*.
- ◆ More than 85 UC Irvine Healthcare physicians were listed as “Best Doctors in America” by Best Doctors Inc., an organization that bases its selection on survey results from other physicians.
- ◆ *U.S. News & World Report* ranks the School of Humanities’ creative writing program – producer of such noted authors as Michael Chabon, Alice Sebold and Richard Ford – 6th nationally.

Did you know?

- ◆ UCI ranks among the top U.S. universities – public and private – in the number of undergraduate applications.
- ◆ Having enrolled its initial class in 2009, the UCI School of Law is the first public law school to open in California in more than 40 years.
- ◆ The Donald Bren School of Information & Computer Sciences is the first in the UC system and among the fastest-growing programs of its kind in the nation.
- ◆ UCI’s 124,000 graduates include leaders in the arts, sciences, business, education – all walks of life. Among them are three Pulitzer Prize winners and the architect of the “HTTP/1.1” Internet protocol used worldwide.
- ◆ UCI offers 82 undergraduate degree programs, as well as 53 master’s, an M.D., Ed.D., J.D. and 45 Ph.D. programs.
- ◆ UCI academic preparation programs touch the lives of tens of thousands of K-12 students in California each year, and many serve as national models.
- ◆ UC Irvine Extension annually offers more than 4,000 university-level professional and personal enrichment courses, including 35 certificate programs and 18 specialized studies programs.
- ◆ UCI teams have earned 26 national titles in nine sports, and 63 individual Anteaters have won national titles; 42 have competed in the Olympics.
